Tap the Congress icon within the app for schedules, session details, maps and even a guide to Chicago! All of these resources and more are available right [here](#) at your fingertips!

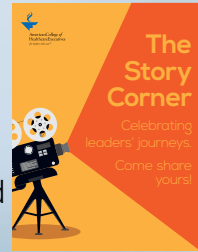


2. Prep for Easy Check-In
